Hanspeter Serazio of Coxsackie, NY passed away peacefully at home with his family by his side on March 24, 2021 after a brief battle with cancer.

Hans was born in Germany on June 29, 1938, and raised in Bad Sackingen by his parents, Karl and Maria Serazio. After apprenticing as a chef, Hans traveled northern Europe to master his trade. Hans came to America in 1964, working in LA, Florida, and New Jersey before coming to the Catskills. He worked at Koch's restaurant in Leeds, where he met his wife Carol. Throughout his career, he owned and operated Finch's restaurant, sold exotic foods, and ended his career at Sharon's in Coxsackie.

Hans shared his lifelong love of fishing with his daughters, granddaughters and grandsons. He also enjoyed many deep-sea trips over the years with friends and family, as recently as this past summer with his Son-In-Law Will.

Hans also enjoyed travel with his wife. They visited family in Germany many times, and also traveled extensively throughout Europe. Since the 1980's Hans and Carol enjoyed many trips to Lancaster County, PA, where they enjoyed the farmland and Amish community, and made lifelong friends. They also traveled across the US, visiting more than 40 states, including a trip to New Orleans in 2019 to celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary. Hans and Carol often brought their grandchildren along on trips to the ocean, Lancaster County, and the White Mountains in NH.

Hans is survived by his loving wife of 51 years Carol Mambert Serazio; his devoted daughters Cara and her husband William Manosh, and Claudine and her husband Patrick West. He is also survived by his beloved grandchildren, Kady and Alexandria Plant, and Henry and Sam West. In Germany he is survived by his sister Rosemarie Barth, and her husband Norbert who was a lifelong friend, as well as a niece and 2 nephews, and their families.

Due to Covid-19 concerns the family is having a private church service, with a memorial to be planned at a safer time.
