Irene A. Hazelton, 86, of Coxsackie, passed away on Saturday, January 28, 2017. She was born in Albany on November 29, 1930, the daughter of the late John William and Mary Agnes Walker. After graduation from Altamont High School she worked for General Electric in Schenectady, and was relocated to their office in Coxsackie. She was introduced to Kendall Hazelton and they married a year later and started their family. With her husband's dream of a house on the Hudson River, she reluctantly agreed to purchase a historical fixer upper with one condition - to add a kitchen on the south side of the home so she could see the river. They continued to grow their family and worked hard to remodel their home. In 1977, she was predeceased by her beloved husband. Irene had a strong spirit and determination. She worked full time while raising their five children. She would run between baseball fields and sports practices and games, splitting her time between her children's activities. After retiring from Coxsackie –Athens School District in 1991, where she worked for over 20 years, she enjoyed traveling with the Coxsackie Seniors on trips to Italy, Ireland, Alaska, and the Panama Canal. She also enjoyed her time touring the country with her sister Gladys and her late brother-in-law Herbert Kronsberg, later spending winters in Florida with them. Irene was strong in body, mind, and spirit and lived her life with a "never give up attitude". She loved spending time with her children, grandchildren, family, and friends and in her later years enjoyed just sitting and relaxing looking out at the river.

She is survived by her children Kendall Hazelton (Louann Miller) of Latham, Guy (Suzanne) Hazelton of Coxsackie, Mary (Joseph) Sterantino of Castleton, John (Beth) Hazelton of Selkirk, and Ralph (Christie) Hazelton of Athens; grandchildren- Kendall (Kirsten) and Patrick(Janelle) Hazelton; Emily Sterantino, Joseph and Zachary Lisa; Alexander, Lauren, and Colleen Hazelton; Haley Ciccone, Keegan Hazelton and great grandchild Atticus Hazelton. She is also survived by her sister Gladys Kronsberg of Tiverton, RI as well as many nieces, nephews, family, and friends. Irene was predeceased by her husband Kendall Hazelton, and her beloved first grandchild Seana Hazelton. She is a member of the Columbiette's Auxiliary of Coxsackie Knight of Columbus Council 548 and the Coxsackie Seniors.
